Welcome to HWAY Fishing & Bundi Adventurers!

Congratulations, you have decided to have the experience of a lifetime! With HWAY fishing your sense of adventure meets your desire to catch that elusive trophy fish while experiencing the majestic Orange River, Namibian desert, African sun sets and more stars than you could ever imagine!

Below we outline the itinerary of your specialized fishing safari. Remember one thing though, this is African time, and we love to go with the flow of the Orange River, so times are merely a guideline...

ARRIVAL DAY

At your leisure arrive at base camp, just over the Namibian border from South Africa. Between 2 and 5pm would be ideal, to relax, maybe have a swim, settle in and prepare for dinner introductions.

Dinner, normally around 7, will be a traditional African Braai. While the fires are burning, we shall ignite your spirit..

- Safety first as we inform you of the necessary Health and Safety requirements
- Issue your drum for packing clothes and bedding, refer to literature provided.
- Tackle talk, where we confirm the conversations and recommendations given via email/WhatsApp. This also gives you an opportunity to ask some specific questions regarding the finer details of terminal tackle prep e.g., knots, leaders and lures for day one of fishing.
- Braai, drinks from the cashless bar and fun will be available to all guests



Here we go...



DAY 1

- 06h00 – 07h30 Start with practical rafting instruction for your safety
 - This will cover paddling techniques
 - Safety in case of capsize
 - How to handle rapids.
 - Camp basics
 - Breakfast will also be available from 06h00
- 07h30-08h00 Pack rafts and depart
- Stops are determined by 3 factors
 - Guides or experienced fisherman/guests
 - Water level
 - River conditions
- First overnight stop is predetermined but will ideally be near a deep, still, hole perfect for some monster Orange river Barbel fishing.
- Remember to expect some late afternoon desert winds, sometimes a bit unpleasant but generally easy to deal with so don't fall too far behind
- Night one will have you adjusting to sleeping under African skies, not difficult at all after a delicious dinner provided by the guides.



DAY 2 - 4

- Waking up in the desert is a treat with a coffee pot hissing on the coals! Breakfast will be provided by the guides but as stated previously this is African time and we may decide to tighten our lines on some early morning yellows while the guides prepare the first meal of the day!
- Stops will be erratic and determined only by your will and Mama Africa!
- Evenings will become a routine of “find a still deep hole for barbell fishing” at your leisure, guide prepared meals and desert sunsets!



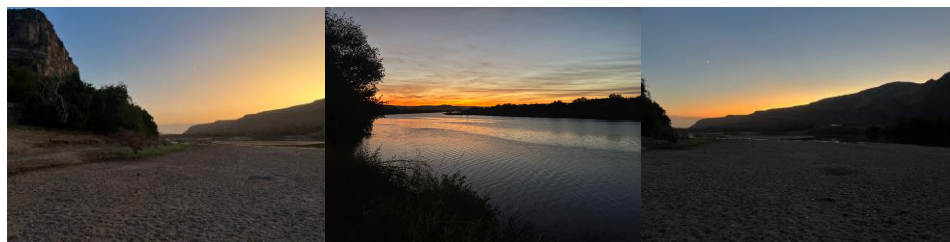
Here we go...
